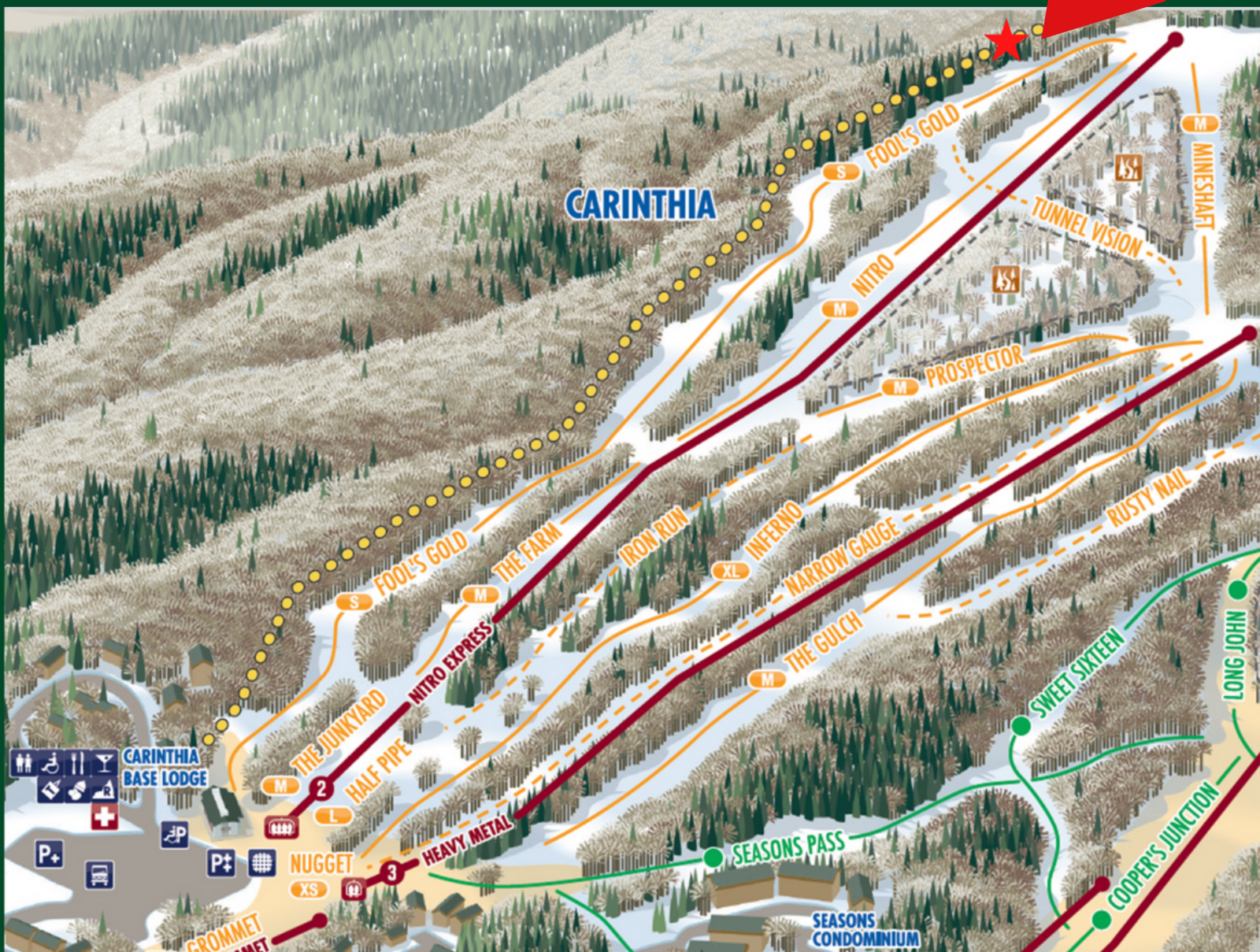
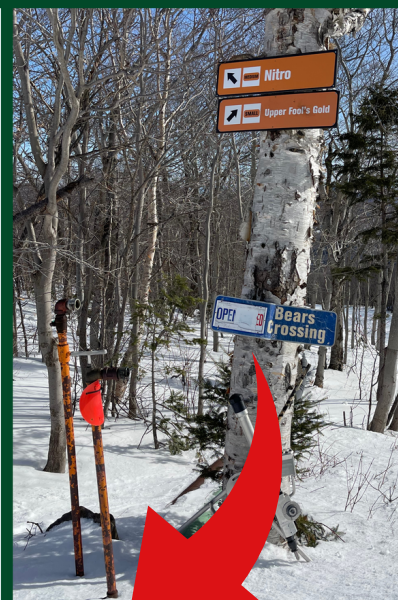


GUIDE TO THE BEARS CROSSING SKI HOME TRAIL

The entrance to Bears Crossing's Ski Home Trail is located on upper Fool's Gold, just below the top of Carinthia's Nitro Lift. It veers off to the right, with signs posted to indicate that you are leaving Mount Snow and entering private property without lift access. The Ski Home Trail is open during the winter *only* when trail conditions allow. There may be signs on the Bears Crossing MOOver shuttle and at the entrance to Upper Fool's Gold that indicate trail status. If the trail is roped off or trail conditions are poor, avoid taking it for your safety. Use the trail at your own risk. Bears Crossing's Ski Home Trail is on private property and does not have snowmaking capabilities. When conditions allow, the trail is regularly groomed. It is not patrolled by Mount Snow staff. While on the trail, be vigilant for potential obstacles (e.g., snow trekkers, sleds, fallen branches, and the like). If emergency assistance is needed on the trail, call Mount Snow Ski Patrol at 802-464-4005 during Mount Snow hours of operation only.
